Resolution establishing Regulations for Temporary Parking Permit for

Construction Vehicles in the Village of Cooperstown Proposed Local Law 3 of 2016

The following regulations apply to a permit for temporary parking of construction vehicles in the Village of Cooperstown on the streets designated for paid parking, only during the timeframe paid parking is effective.

A temporary parking permit for construction vehicles is hereby established for the designated village streets for paid parking in accordance with the following regulations:

- Up to three (3) temporary construction parking permits may be issued to allow vehicles needed for the construction/renovation of a building to park in the vicinity of said building and not be subject to the time limit parking.
- Temporary Parking Construction permits do not exempt permit holders from all paid parking fees when in effect on Village Streets. A \$15.00 per day, per vehicle fee will be assessed. A trailer is considered a separate vehicle and subject to the regulations contained herein. In addition to the per day, per vehicle charge, an application fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.
- Permits are available for purchase on weekdays during normal business hours.
 In addition, the Village Clerk may schedule occasional evening hours and weekend hours for the sale of permits with the approval of the Board of Trustees.
- A Temporary Parking for Construction Permit is valid only for the specific vehicle for which it is issued, and may only be transferred to another vehicle on the specific construction/renovation project for the time period for which it was issued.
- A Temporary Parking for Construction Permit shall be evidenced by displaying the permit on the driver's side area of the dashboard or by attachment to the trailer.
- Permit holders must contact, at least 24 hours in advance, the DPW Superintendent or designee who will ensure by signage noting Construction Permit Parking only, that a space or spaces are designated as close to the construction location as possible.
- The permit(s) is valid only for the period of time for which it is issued, but no longer than a seven (7) day maximum with an option to extend without an additional application fee.
